



IGSA Code of Conduct and Ethics

Standards of conduct and ethics are part of the ASA National Code, Southern California Regulations, and IGSA operational documents. A coach, player, parent, umpire, spectator, or ASA/IGSA official shall not violate any of the following:

- Coaches, players, parents, umpires, spectators, and ASA/IGSA official are expected to observe sportsmanlike conduct on and off the field at practices, games, or at any IGSA or ASA related activity.
- Crude, obscene, or discourteous behavior will not be allowed towards coaches, players, parents, umpires, spectators, or ASA/IGSA official for any reason during any IGSA or ASA related activity.
- Verbally or physically attacking, threatening, or inappropriate contact of a coach, player, parent, umpire, spectator, or ASA/IGSA official is prohibited at all times.
- Consumption or use of alcoholic beverages, tobacco products, or drugs on the field, inside or outside of the dugout, or in any area of game play is prohibited.
- The Head Coaches shall be responsible for the behavior of their team's coaches, managers, players, parents, and spectators during games and practices. Coaches shall not leave a game or practice until all their players have been picked up by a parent or guardian.

- Any offending coach, player, parent, umpire, spectator, or ASA/IGSA official will be subject to immediate expulsion from the activity. Further sanctions will be in accordance with IGSA By-Laws and Operational Documents.
- Complaints of inappropriate behavior shall be presented to the Player Agent and Division Director within 48 hours after the incident.
